APPOINTMENTS. Robin Michaud, Town Clerk, appeared to swear in the newly elected Selectmen. This is the 363rd Board of Selectmen for the Town of Marblehead. All newly elected officials were also sworn in by the Town Clerk.

Motion made and seconded to nominate Jackie Belf-Becker as Chair for the coming year. All in favor.

Jackie Belf-Becker continued the meeting as chair.

POLICE DEPARTMENT. Promotions. Chief Robert O. Picariello appeared before the Board as it relates to promotions within the Police Department. Mr. Christensen and Mr. Murray recused themselves from the meeting. Mark D. Mills appeared before the Board. Chief Picariello recommended Mark Mills for the position of Captain. Motion made and seconded to appoint Mark D. Mills permanent Captain effective May 15, 2011. All in favor. Nicholas Economou and Sean Brady appeared before the Board. Chief Picariello recommended both officers for the position of Sergeant. Motion made and seconded to appoint Nicholas Economou and Sean Brady as permanent Sergeants effective May 15, 2011. All in favor. Sean Sweeney appeared before the Board. Chief Picariello recommended Sean Sweeney for the position of Acting Lieutenant. Motion made and seconded to appoint Sean Sweeney as Acting Lieutenant effective May 15, 2011. All in favor.

Mr. Christensen and Mr. Murray returned to the meeting.

POLICE DEPARTMENT. Human Resources. Motion made and seconded to authorize Chief Picariello to call for the Sergeant, Lieutenant and Captains test for the fall 2011 in order for the Department to have a candidates list available in April 2012. All in favor.

Indemnification. Motion made and seconded to indemnify Officer Christopher Gallo for injuries sustained while on duty May 8, 2011. All in favor.

Update. Chief Picariello updated the Board on activities at the Department: An area Chief was brought in to present a “Tactical Conversation” workshop; new officers are back from the Academy and getting out in the community; officers walking the beat since mid April; Strategic Planning Committee continues to meet; officers are in the schools having lunch with the kids; developing connection with the YMCA and family nights; MHTV producing show on the Department; Department is participating in a 2 week Camp Program with Salem Police in which 10 kids from town attend each week at no cost. The Chief will continue to keep the Board apprised.
