MINUTES. Motion made and seconded to approve the minutes from April 29, 2009. All in favor.

PERMISSION. Abbot Hall. Chamberlain Sailing Dory. Motion made and seconded to approve the request from Wayne T. Butler, Chairman Marblehead Historical Commission, to accept a 20' 8.25" Chamberlain Sailing Dory from the Marblehead Museum and Historical Society and to place it in the Auditorium at Abbot Hall. 1 voted in favor, 4 opposed. The motion failed.

TRAFFIC AND SAFETY. Beverly Avenue. Motion made and seconded to refer a letter from Laura Best requesting a no parking sign on Beverly Avenue to the Traffic and Safety Committee for further review. All in favor.

VOTE. Contract. Harbor Side Seawall Repair. Motion made and seconded to award the contract for the construction of the Ocean Avenue Harbor side seawall repair project to the responsible and eligible bidder offering the lowest price Unified Contracting Inc. of Melrose, Massachusetts in the amount of two hundred and thirteen thousand eight hundred and forty nine and 50/100 dollars (\$213,849.50) and authorize the Chairman to sign the contract on behalf of the Board. PERMISSION. POD Placement. Motion made and seconded to approve the request of Robert and Christine Palermo, 14 Merrill Road, to place a storage POD in front of their home May 15 to May 22, 2009 subject to approval from the Marblehead Police Department and receipt of the required Certificate of Insurance. All in favor.

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS. Street Resurfacing.
