COMMUNITY DISCUSSION. Combatting Racism. The Board of Selectmen invited members of the Marblehead Racial Justice Team, Task Force against Discrimination and Team Harmony to their meeting to talk about racism and racial injustice in the community and to start a dialogue on how the Town, and these organizations, can support each other and work together collaboratively to combat racism. Each organization made a brief introduction to the Board, stating their mission, vision and detailing contributions they have made to the Town as well as their goals moving forward. A lengthy discussion followed. Committee members stated the importance of the Town and committees working together, sharing resources and the potential of having quarterly conversations to continue the current momentum.

CONTRACT. Bituminous Concrete. Motion made and seconded to award a contract to Aggregate Industries North East Region Inc. of Saugus MA in the amount of One hundred and sixty-eight thousand two hundred and fifty dollars (\$168,250.00) and authorize the Chair to sign on behalf of the Board. Motion made and seconded to amend the contract for the Fort Sewall land restoration project between the Town and Sciaba Construction by increasing the amount by seven thousand five hundred and eighty-eight and 90/100 dollars (\$7,588.90) and authorize the Chari to sign on behalf of the Board.
