Elizabeth & Bryan Burns

This is a Public Hearing for: New fence

- 6ft. high, solid fence along South property line.

- 4ft. high, open along West property line.

✓ It was moved, seconded, and voted (4-0) that no estates are materially affected and to grant a Certificate of Appropriateness for: All work as proposed.

2. 235 Washington St.

This is an application for: Skylight measuring 45" x 46".

Issues discussed include: Abutter voiced concerns with the approval process, and the failure of the homeowner to document existing and proposed construction accurately. Abutter felt 'build-first / ask permission later' approach is unfair and should not be tolerated.

✓ 3. 7 Cowell St.

Laura Consigli
