  - d) Proof of abutter notification (a signed letter of notification from each abutter *or* a U.S. Postal Service receipt of notification for each abutter). Applicant must allow for 14-day comment period after notification as indicated on sample notification letter. (This may be submitted at the time of the hearing)
  - e) Structures planned for the use of intended fowl (including fences and corrals)
  - f) Dimensions of the area where fowl will be kept
  - g) Distance of housing and enclosures from all abutters' structures, property lines, and wetlands
  - A written management plan appropriate for the species of animals kept, for the following:
    - a) Manure (MMP)
    - b) Feed Management Plan (FMP)
    - c) Pest Management Plan (PMP)
