## MINUTES, February 1, 2017

Meeting called to order at 7:30 pm.

### Opioid Working Group:

- The community screening of the movie “If Only” shown on January 24<sup>th</sup> at the Veterans School in the PAC at 7 pm had 180 attendees.
- The next meeting will be February 7<sup>th</sup>.
- Mary Wheeler, of the Healthy Streets Outreach Program located in Lynn will be providing Narcan training to the group in the future.
- Chris Herren, former NBA star will be speaking to students on March 13<sup>th</sup> at the Veterans School in the PAC at 7 pm on substance abuse.

### Landfill Update / Transfer Station Update:

- Kleinfelder has met with Maverick to review change orders.
- \$2.5 million dollars is owed to Maverick.
- Prevailing wage violation has been indicated.
- Reviewing certified payroll records.
- Meeting in executive session with the Board of Selectmen on March 6<sup>th</sup>.
- Meeting with the Finance Committee on Monday, February 27<sup>th</sup> to review budgets for FY 18.
- Rolling stock meeting will take place on February 7<sup>th</sup>. The cost to repair the roll off truck is \$9000.00 and the cost for a new pickup truck is \$42,000.

### Director’s Report:

- Mosquito control pesticide exclusion has been formed. New legislation was passed that states that mosquito control no longer goes thru the local Board of Health rather it goes thru the Department of Agriculture.
- Cancer rates in the local area were handed out to the Board. Melanoma had the highest rate.
- Todd is writing a letter to the Reporter about all the composting that is available as the transfer station with a valid facilities sticker.
- The town website will be updated soon.

### Old /New Business:

- Helaine told the Board that Fraffie Welch of the Marblehead Reporter is having some health issues.
- Andrew attended Teen Substance Abuse meeting.
- Diana Schwalbe of 17 Arnold Terrace came before the Board to ask about the transfer station project. More specifically, when the swap shed is reopening.

- Helaine attended the teen substance abuse grant meeting on January 30<sup>th</sup>. Parents from Swampscott attended as well. A tagline was put together “Where’s the Party”. This will be used to help educate students and parents as the prom season approaches.
