Web-based video conferencing meeting of Board of Health via Zoom.

Meeting called to order at 4:00 PM.

Andrew stated that as of May 6th there were over 72000 cases in MA and 158 cases in Marblehead. There have been 18 deaths in Marblehead. Long term health care facilities have been hit the hardest with the virus. At this time, May 18th is the tentative date for reopening the state. Mass.gov is constantly being updated with information.

Andrew discussed how the town is following the governor's guidelines and the town administrator has formed a committee on how to enforce guidelines and continue to keep everyone safe. The town website provides information on COVID-19 and also via Code Red calls go out throughout the town and three message boards are located around the town.

The Park and Rec department has removed all the basketball hoops to prevent any games from taking place.

Florist shops will be open for Mother's Day flowers. Shops have a limited number of workers and sales will only be done remotely.

On May 7th golf courses will be opening with restrictions. Such as: no motorized carts, tee times will be 15 minutes apart, no caddies, only groups of four or less and no touch ball retrieval from holes.
