MINUTES, June 4, 2020

Web-based video conferencing meeting of Board of Health via Zoom.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM

Andrew stated that there are 224 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and no deaths in Marblehead. Of the 224 cases 136 are active cases.

Phase 2 of reopening the state is scheduled to begin June 8th. At this time guidelines and regulations will be in place for camps and pools. The JCC is planning on having camp this summer and opening the pool. Other camps in town have cancelled for the season.

On June 15th municipal buildings in town will be reopening. The public will be required to wear masks, social distance and bring their own pens. Rest rooms will be closed for public use. Appointments will be necessary for residents wishing to discuss any matters. The hours of operation in the buildings will be adjusted so that cleaning can take place.

Helaine and Andrew both discussed the reopening of retail and restaurants in town. Outdoor seating will be an option for restaurants. Sidewalk sales are an option for retail stores. Each business will need to have a COVID plan put together and also train employees. Restaurants will require a contact number from a patrons table in the event of a positive case happens. This will enable contact tracing to be done.

MOTION to approve meeting minutes of April 16, 2020 and April 22, 2020 as submitted. All in favor and motion passed.

The next meeting will take place on Thursday, June 11th at 7pm.
