LICENSING. One Day Liquor. Lumiere Lauren. 123 Pleasant Street. Motion made and seconded to approve the request from Charlotte Daher de Garcie, Lumiere Lauren, for a 1 Day Liquor License on Wednesday, May 8, 2019 from 6:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. at 123 Pleasant Street, subject to the following:

- 1. Delivery of and receipt by the Licensing Authority of the required fee (\$50.)
- 2. Delivery of and receipt by the Licensing Authority of Proof that the alcohol will be purchased from an authorized source.
- 3. Proof that the applicant can receive proper delivery; provide proper storage and disposal of all alcoholic beverages purchased all in accordance with the requirements of G. L. c. 138.

Alcohol shall be purchased from Kappy's in Everett. On a polled vote the Board voted as follows: Mr. Grader, in favor; Mrs. Jacobi, in favor; Mr. Nye, in favor; Mrs. Belf-Becker, in favor.

PARKING REGULATIONS. West Shore Drive. Motion made and seconded to approve, on the recommendation of the Police Chief, the following parking regulation on West Shore Drive: No Parking in the southerly side of West Shore Drive beginning on the north easterly corner of Evans Road and continuing in a northerly direction for a distance of sixty six feet on West Shore Drive. Motion made and seconded, on the recommendation of the Police Chief, to make permanent the following parking regulation: "No Parking – Here to Driveway" for a distance of 5 feet in the southerly direction from the existing driveway at 40 South Street. All in favor.
