

Harbor Regulations Amendment Covid-19 2020

Due to the current epidemic, harbor regulations will have temporary amended rule changes/additions. These amendments will be in place until further notice.

Public Access:

All town facilities (docks, gangways, piers, ramps, parking lots and buildings) will require face masks at all times and other PPE (Personal Protection Equipment) will be recommended. 6 foot social distancing must be adhered to at all times. All docks will be for pick-up and drop-off only. No loitering of any kind is allowed. Vessels must not be left unattended unless given permission from the Harbormaster. Public returning from sea will have the right of way when transitioning the gangways and docks.

Any violations of these rules will result in closure of the facility.

Waterways:

Rafting of any type is not allowed in all of Marblehead waters.

There will be no anchoring in Marblehead water. Exception will be for fishing and emergencies situations.

Personal water craft must maintain a social distance from all other vessels at all time. (Canoes, kayaks, paddleboards, dinghy's and any sort of floatation craft).

Rules are subject to change without notice.
