

# Lime Rickey's

- Paint white trash box on side of building
- Review wood deck & stairs as all nails need to be pounded in
- · Fix lattice in front of building
  - o Remove sand and push back in place
- \*Brush all sand off deck & stairs
- There will be 3 trash-barrels placed in front of restaurant. The restaurant will be responsible for monitoring and storing of waist until pick up. All trash will be picked up at 7am and should be stored in white trash box on side of building.
- Repair all water damage on rear of building (although may fall under town)

#### **Devereux Beach**

# Park Department

- o Take Skid Steer and push back sand in front of Handicap Spots to even out grade moving up towards playground. Bench has exposed concrete foundation and is a huge hazard. DONE ASAP
- Remove metal fence post that is wrapped in metal wire near crosswalk entrance to Devereux DONE ASAP
- Rake out and dispose of all large rocks
- Create better grade at beach entrance near handicap spot
- Brush all sand of concrete walkways
  - Pavilion, sidewalk in front of Lime Rickey's, etc.
- o Pick up broken asphalt in handicap spot near lot
  - Repair said spot
- Weed all around property
  - Lime Rickeys and along road in particular
- o Remove all seaweed to dump
- Push sand back & remove rocks in parking lot near playground
- Create handicap grade entrance near handicap spots in lot near playground (12/1)
- Weed green island near entrance
- Repaint green island, black anchor, white flag pole, and yellow gates
- o Straighten out wooden fence on road side and repair as needed
- Push sand over man hole near crosswalk
- Install new bike rack
- Bring out all benches and put under pavilions (clean and sand)
- Remove pole with concrete base near entrance as it's a hazard
- White sign near entrance
  - Sand down and repaint (remove graffiti)
- Take back all edges near entrance to expose asphalt near island to allow handicap access
  - follow up with Chip after to see if we will move forward with contacting Conservation)

- Contact Doug Gordon to trim back trees near Lime Rickey's
- o Order new handicap signs
- o Order new signs for pavilion
- Reach out to Artie Graves to Discuss:
  - ▼ Fill Hole before carnival, ask what material is needed ASAP
  - Work with DPW to re-grade sand in parking lot. Push back up to curb.

# Park Department

- o Order new signs that were damaged
- Remove tree dumping sign Done 4/22/15
- o Remove all leftover kayaks & boats from racks and grassy area
- Remove all trash from property
  - Along cliff, entrance, and road
- Once mooring are removed, replace with 4-5 boulders and space out just enough so a person can walk through
- o Once floats removed clean out all
- o Remove all trees from edges of lot that may have died (horizontal laying trees)
- o Replace all post and beams along fence near road
- o Remove all seaweed
- o Along sidewalk remove grass/sand along edge to expose asphalt
- o Remove large metal tot box
