- 1) Called to order: 7:00 PM.
- 2) Attendance: Chip and Matt absent.
- 3) Minutes of last meeting: Motion made and seconded to approve the minutes of the last meeting; all in favor.
- 4) Appearances: School Building Oversight Committee representatives did not show up.
- 5) Reports (see attached): Addendum & Actions taken:
 - a) Superintendent:
 - i) <u>Addendum</u>: After discussion, Board felt having volunteers lock the beach gates would be a liability issue. Fields are open, and spring cleanup is going well. 2 turf blankets took some winter damage.
 - ii) <u>Actionable items</u>: Motions were made and seconded to hire the following applicants for seasonal maintenance crew with all in favor: Dan Gienieczko, Ian Cammett, Matt Cashman, and Alani Diaz.
 - b) Recreation Supervisor:
 - Addendum: Jaime is coordinating with the person who offered to donate a whaler to go look at it. National Grand will be sponsoring the playground program shirts again this year. William Ravis has offered to sponsor t-shirts (see attached) and Jaime thinks t-ball is a good fit. Board agreed coming up with some guidelines for sponsorship is a good idea.
