### Float Storage Discussion with Yacht Clubs about increase from \$1.75 to \$2.75

Boston Yacht Club, Easten Yacht Club & Corinithian

Corinthian Yacht Club - Ken Taylor & Anne Harris Asking for reprieve for 2020 storage. Step process for the next few years to budget for it.

Recreation & Parks is willing to work with Yacht Clubs with multiple floats this year. Increase was to offset the town budget deficit. All revenue from floats goes to the General Operating fund not Recreation & Parks budget.

Eastern Yacht Club submitted a proposal with a graduated increase. 13 Floats with \$10k increase over 2019. Would like to phase in over 3 years.

Make a case to the homeowners for the gradual increase to the yacht clubs with multiple floats. Floats are still below market value.

Jack Carney- increase % (square footage) vs. number of floats

Propose possible 20% (\$2.10/square ft) increase - 20%(\$2.50/square ft)-FY21, 20% FY22, Full price(cap at \$2.75 - FY23 for then freeze for 5 years. Revisist increase in 2028. Support of all yacht clubs present.
