### Park Report

- Field Report
  - Grubs are active on Seaside, Hopkins, Middle Village, and Veterans. They have been treated with B. Thuringiensis. A bacteria that will quickly infect and kill the grubs. Despite being unsightly, they rarely cause lasting damage.
  - Starting Monday, aeration combined with seeding, will begin. Hopkins and Middle Village has been aerated and seeded
  - Fertilizer will come after. Probably the second week of October.
  - Baseball and Softball fields have been sod cut and cleaned up. This makes spring prep much easier. (Hobbs is still yet to be done, but it doesn't take long.) Minor field at Gatchell's was mowed, lined, and given special attention for the Police vs Firemen game.
  - Large potholes on the Stramski lot have been addressed. They are not perfect, but show a good faith effort to make them better.
  - Comm center garden beds are on the list for weeding, as time allows.
