Field Report

- Despite treatment, grubs have been active on Middle Village, parts of Seaside and Vets. A third round of spot seeding is probably necessary. This weeks colder temps should drive them down deeper, where squirrels and birds can't detect them.
- Fall round of fertilizer is almost complete. Lower Village, MHS, Memorial Park, Abbot Hall and Library are left.
- Irrigation is off at all properties except Library. Next week would be a good time to start draining and blowing out systems.
- Community Center was weeded and planters at entrance were replanted with fall plantings.
- Concrete footings from both pavilions at the beach were removed.
- Area around beach garage has been cleaned up and reorganized.
- Forman Report
  - Cutting Fields with 52" riding mowers, painting fields after they are cut.
  - Cutting other properties after fields are done.
  - Brought in all beach stuff sheds, signs, lifeguard stands and boardwalks.
  - Cut Brown school for the first time. Long and thick.
  - Closed restrooms at Lighthouse, Devereux beach, Crocker Park and Fort Sewall.
  - Added 3/4" dense grade gravel to lower parking lot at Stramskis to correct flooding issue.
  - Needed to repaint football lower high school change direction.
  - Groomed piper and blew off leaves as needed.
  - Greg and John D. put up new fence at Mary Alley for Building commissioner.
  - Request by resident for Port-a-potties over the winter
  - Budget season will return to regular schedule
