Chandler Hovey Park

Strategic plan 2016- 2021

This will replace the previous plan adopted by the Recreation and Parks Commission in 2011. It is the intention of the Commission that this become the guiding document through 2021.

Historical

Previous plan 2011

These are all projects identified at the time that needed attention. There was a priority list created that was dependent upon financial, manpower, and administrative resources. The document that was created identifying everything below was done in subcommittee. The subcommittee was made up of members of the recreation and Park commission as well as interested citizens from both Marblehead neck and elsewhere around town. Some of this information was adopted as part of the previous strategic plan.

Grounds

Mow grass on a regular basis. Done

Collect trash on a regular basis in season. Done

Several stumps on the property need to be ground. Done

Cut back and/or remove overgrown brush. Done

Remove the rusted outflow pipe in the rock near the lower pavilion.

Done

Remove rusted pipes sticking out of the rocks near the pavilion by the parking lot. Done

Plant native plantings around the bathroom facility.

All landscaping needs to be "bulletproof".

Trees

Check all trees for health and remove if necessary. Done

Should the invasive Norway Maple near the bathroom be removed? Done

Shrubs on the property have not been maintained and have become overgrown.

Trim shrubs back to their correct appearance or selectively remove if not appropriate for the site.

Structure and roof need to be repaired at the least

Upper pavilion near the parking lot

The Recreation and Park Commission will meet with the subcommittee from time to time The Recreation and Park Commission will give approval to all or parts of the plan. funding will then need to be secured Once funding is secured permits will be required from various town departments

The following portion of this document was created by discussion among the members of the Town of Marblehead Recreation and Park Commission in April 2016. It will be included with individual plans for other properties as part of an overall strategic plan.

Projects remaining from 2011 that were identified but have yet to be completed

Grounds

Plant native plantings around the bathroom facility.

All landscaping needs to be "bulletproof".

Look into the possibility of replacing the trees that were intentionally killed by gasoline 10 years ago.

Look into the possibility of replacing the vegetation along the property line that abuts the parking lot. The original plantings were cut and ruined by a resident fifteen years ago.

Lower Pavilion

Replace

Upper pavilion near the parking lot

Replace

The following list represents new areas of attention as determined by the Commission.

Benches

- Sand and paint all benches.
- Do we want to make all benches uniform or alter location?
- We would like all wooden benches to be the same style and material.

Walls

· All walls need to be pointed.

Guardrail

 It is bad in several places. Look into regulations on requiring it to be metal or could we replace it with wood or other more welcoming solutions. Presently it is very industrial looking.

Walkways

- Do we want to keep the current location of the walkways or do we want to consider restoring them to their original location?
- Puddling occurs now with the material that is used to create the walkway.
- We want to create handicapped access to the pavilion closest to the parking lot.
- It must be accessible using the best materials for the disabled.

Signage

- Make sure that all signage on the property is in the appropriate place to be clearly visible
- A generous donation has been made for a new sign for the property. Any leftover money will be used to fund a passive park donation fund.

Security

- Discussions are ongoing with the Marblehead Police Department and the Town Administrator regarding security.
- The position of park security is being discussed and attempts are being made to fund the position.
- To date there has been no commitment from the Police Department regarding locking of the gates on a regular basis.
- The superintendent will continue to work with the chief of police.

Oil house

The slate roof needs to be repaired.

- The trim needs to be replaced (where needed) and painted.
- The trim that is in good condition needs to be scraped, sanded, and painted.
- Check the historical significance of the door.
- Have the brick repointed.

Items of historical significance

- In addition to the oil house the following are of historical significance on the property.
- Ring bolts
- Original walkway
- Original lighthouse markers
- The land that the light tower sits on his owned by the federal government.
- It is that portion of land and the light tower that is on the National Register of Historic Places.
- The rest of the property is not designated historical.
- It is recommended that the Commission meet with Bill Conley to gain as much information as we can regarding the historical significance of individual components of the property.
- Create high-end historical signage about the property and the individual historical components.
