Recreation and Parks Meeting Minutes

09/30/2014

<u>NOTE</u>: The following is a **summary** of matters submitted at a meeting of the Recreation and Parks Commission in accordance with <u>M.G.L Chapter 39</u> and the <u>Massachusetts Open Meeting Laws</u>. Meetings are often recorded and tapes used as an aid.

- 1) Call to order: Chip called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.
- 2) Attendance:
 - a) Present (constituting a quorum): Chip, Linda, Jerry, Derek, and Sam.
 - b) Absent: None.
- 3) Minutes of last meeting: Motion made and seconded to approve the minutes of the 09/16/14 meeting; all in favor.
- 4) Appearance: Becky Curran appeared to give an update on the status of the Fort Sewall Project (see attached) and distributed a large detailed report for the Board's information to be kept on file in both offices. The report includes the planned phases of the project. Becky has submitted requests for grants and may be asking the Board for matching funds from the Curtis Coffin Fund, and will be putting together detailed bid proposals for consideration. Discussion included immediate repairs needed and ideas for future improvements, and the possibility of the need to go to Town meeting for funds. Becky will keep Tim updated as bids are received.
- 5) Reports (see attached). Addendum:
 - a) Tim:
 - i) Schools: School Superintendent Mary Ann Perry wants to be contacted first for all matters regarding Recreation Department's interaction with the schools. Discussion included protocol, Town Department vs. Private recreation organizations, and the electronic backpack. Travis, Tim, and Sam will be meeting with the Superintendent next week to begin a dialog.
 - ii) Hopkins field: discussion of watering, aerating, and fertilizing.
 - iii) <u>Devereux Beach playground:</u> discussion of who is removing the old playground equipment. Tim will contact the contractor to check who's responsible.
 - iv) Christmas tree burning: Discussion of reestablishing the traditional Christmas tree burning as requested by the Fire Chief. The Health Department will also be voting on the matter. Board is generally in favor of the event if the Highway Department agrees to help clean up after the burning and the order of conditions can be changed with Conservation. Tim will follow up.
 - v) <u>Big Bellies:</u> Board is not in favor of renewing the software license since there's no money in the budget and this yearly cost was never agreed on when the Board of Health purchased the Big Bellies. Discussion of use of these 20 cans around the town and how the Board of Health is supposed to be the department in charge of public trash barrels. Tim will check with the company representative to see if there are any other options such as a maintenance agreement and report back to the Board. Tim has also been fielding complaints about the smell from these barrels.
 - b) Travis: Working on "Twitter" account as well as "Facebook".

6) Old Business:

- a) Rental Fees: Discussion of what the school's charge for gym fees; the schools charge \$22 or \$28 an hour for a gym dependent on use, and use of the entire field house is \$80 or \$100 an hour dependent on use. After discussion, **Motion** made and seconded to approve the following fee structure effective January 1, 2015:
 - i) Gym: \$30 an hour.
 - ii) Arts & Crafts & Conference rooms: \$50 for first hour, \$30 for second hour.
 - iii) Game room & Dining rooms: \$75 for first hour, \$50 for second hour.
- b) Weekend beach parking: Board will consider raising the price of visitor parking and discuss it at the next meeting.
- c) Paddle Board: Discussion of East Coast SUP contract for next year to include her running programs independently of the Department this past season, parking spaces, advertising, trailer storage, administration, on site program registrations, having a department run program vs. contracting, and an RFP. Board will take the matter under consideration and discuss it further at the next meeting.

7) New Business:

- a) Sam:
 - i) Warned department may get a call regarding trash on the field behind the High School.
 - ii) Hobbs field needs to be turned over. Tim will put it on the punch list. Sam also requested the fence needs to be repaired.
- b) <u>Derek</u>: Youth Baseball fixed fencing on the "Major" field and now requests the department pay half the bill. **Motion** made and seconded to authorize the expenditure of up to \$2700 for the repair pending the receipt of an invoice from Century Fence; all in favor.
- c) <u>Jerry</u>: Was approached by a Selectmen regarding cutting Hammond Park, which belongs to the Electric Company. Discussion of outsourcing all small properties. Board will take it into consideration.
- d) Chip: Asked Tim to go ahead and post the vacant grounds keeping position.
- e) <u>Motion to censure:</u> Discussion of the inappropriate comment made by Derek Norcross regarding Ric Reynolds at the last meeting. **Motion** made and seconded to censure Derek for violating the Open Meeting Law; 3 in favor, 1 opposed.
- f) Correspondence: 1 Notice of public hearing; no actions required.
- Timekeeping: Meeting Adjourned: 9:47 PM. Next meeting to be determined.
