Present for approval Trey Blackmer and Colin Daly for seasonal grounds keeper.


# **Community Center**




Construction to begin next week next week in community center. The data rack that currently resides in current recreation office will be relocated to the closet with the voicemail/phones are located.



Well worth the trip. Good networking with other Recreation & Parks officials from around the state as well as vendors.










Library Box - Builder's Kit Plans
