Recreation and Parks Meeting Minutes

12/03/13

NOTE: The following is a **summary** of matters submitted at a meeting of the Recreation and Parks Commission in accordance with M.G.L Chapter 39 and the Massachusetts Open Meeting Laws. Meetings are often recorded and tapes used as an aid.

- 1) Call to order: Derek Norcross called the meeting to order at 7:04 PM.
- 2) Attendance:
 - a) Present (constituting a quorum): Derek, Linda, and Jerry.
 - b) Absent: Chip and Bob.
- 3) Minutes of last meeting: Motion made and seconded to approve the minutes of the 11/19/13 meeting; all in favor.

4) Appearances:

- a) <u>Lisa Gery:</u> Appeared to request removal of the bell at the Gerry Playground Structure (see attached). After discussion, Brendan will contact the manufacturer to ensure there are no warranty issues if pieces are removed, and ask how to properly fill the holes left to prevent corrosion and bug infestation.
- b) Walter Jacob & Lynn Breed: Walter presented preliminary plans (see attached) for a replacement pavilion adjacent to the parking lot at Chandler Hovey, to be donated to the Town by Lynn. Several neighbors attended as well. Derek emphasized this was a preliminary proposal and nothing would be voted on at this meeting. Walter explained the concept plans and answered questions from the Board and the audience. Landscaping design and handicapped access were also discussed. The neighbor's took turns voicing their concerns regarding usage, policing, trash, size of the proposed structure, and changing the character of the park; they are opposed to changing the space into any type of a performance area or amphitheater and want it to remain a passive area for ocean viewing. Lynn and Walter welcomed the feedback and will meet to discuss adjusting the design to address concerns. Board thanked everyone for attending and explained that this was only the first step in a larger process before anything would be approved.

Dear Chair Belf-Becker:

I apologize in advance for bringing this issue to the Selectmen but I have not been successful in obtaining a resolution on my own.

For 23 years, my husband and I have enjoyed living in our home which abuts Stramski Way and is located directly behind Header's Haven. We have never had a noise problem with the park until it was rebuilt last winter. The new structure now features 2 metal bells which children ring sometimes for as much as 12 hours a day. The sound is quite loud, carries easily, and is unnerving.

I first spoke with Brendan Egan of the Recreation and Parks Department this spring when the weather was nice enough to leave our windows open. I waited patiently but after many weeks of the constant clanging, I called Mr. Egan again. He promised to look into the matter. Again I waited a few weeks but when the ringing continued, I left a message with Mr. Sasso hoping that he might orchestrate a quick resolution. He turned it back to Mr. Egan who phoned me with the following explanation. Apparently, the park was designed to resemble a ship and the bells are part of the nautical theme. He felt strongly that they should remain, and that children would not enjoy the facility as much if they were removed. He learned from the company who provided the play structure that there are no alternatives to the bells that would be less audible. That is the last conversation I had with him and that was over a month ago.

Having accompanied children to the park myself, and having observed the children at play there, I do not feel that their experience would be compromised should the bells be removed. It is a beautiful structure with ample play features to keep any child busy for hours. I am graciously requesting that the selectmen have the bells removed and help restore our neighborhood "chatter" to the level that existed before the new park was built.

I would be happy to discuss this in person with the Board although I certainly don't want to take any more of your time unnecessarily. I realize that this is an issue for only a very few homes, but we've worked very hard to make our home our "sanctuary," and I hope you will be willing to help me restore the peacefulness to which we had become accustomed.

Dear Selectmen:





Recreation Supervisors Report December 3, 2013

Christmas Parade

Plans are being finalized and an email was sent out today to the groups that will be participating in the Parade. We have 15 groups lined up.

Winter/Spring Booklet

Mystery Guest Reader Program

At a recent meeting with Superintendent Maryann Perry, I discussed the idea of launching a Mystery Guess Reader Program which would be sponsored by Marblehead Recreation. She was very interested in the idea and offered to help me with making the program happen. The goal is to have town leaders read short stories and afterwards kids can ask the guest reader question about their job. I anticipate this program taking place in the spring time.

Recreation Commission Meeting December 3, 2013 Superintendent's Report

Parks / Playgrounds / Properties

The staff has been busy with cleanups. With the leaves dropping late this year we are trying to stay ahead of the snow.

Community Center

- The Marblehead For Teens group has notified me they will no longer be using the facility for their activities. This is effective immediately
- The stage in the gym is in the process of being sanded and refinished. It has never been done before and is taking a little longer than expected.

Stramski Property

The Water and Sewer Department has asked for our support in encouraging the start of the SESD sewer line project across Marblehead/Salem. They feel the project is not being considered an emergency and is getting tied up. I have sent letters expressing our concern to the DEP and the Executive Office of Environmental Affairs (handout).

Gatchell Playground

The annual Christmas tree sale has begun and it looks like they are well stocked.

Memorial Park

Dear Mr. Chin:

I am writing to express my concern over the proposed work on the South Essex Sewer District line that runs from Marblehead to Salem, under Marblehead/Salem Harbor. I understand the proposed project is needed and would like to convey to you the importance and urgency of getting this project started to avoid an environmental disaster, which will add unnecessary costs to the Town.

As the Superintendent of Recreation and Parks in Marblehead and the caretaker of the property from which the sewer line exits Marblehead, I am concerned the project, if not started now will interfere with programs and events that take place on the property during the busy summer months. The property is utilized for pram and kayak storage, a summer sailing program, public swimming and sunbathing and numerous picnic and wedding rentals. If the project is not started soon, not only will it expose the harbor to another potentially hazardous break, but also cut into the Recreation and Park Department's funds generated from the planned events on the property.

I would like to emphasize how important it is to start this project as soon as possible and not delay it any further. Not only does it affect the town's sewer line but also the recreation programs and events that take place on the property. Please feel free to contact me if you have any further questions or comments.
