# Recreation and Parks Meeting Minutes 05/24/2016

#### 4) Appearance:

- i) <u>Tim Guy, Kim Day, Daryl Smith, & Dave and Michelle Ferregamo:</u> Came to voice their concern about the Stramski Property
  - (1) Road: the group was concerned about increased use of road due to pier will mean increases need to maintain road. Tim Short will continue to work with DPW to increase road maintaince if necessary during summer months. The board also stressed the road will never be paved due to condition in deed.
  - (2) Wetland: Chip Osborne shared his plans to cut back invasive brush down to the blueberry bushes near wetland. This will also allow the department to offer more gardening plots at Stramski. This will be a collaboration between several groups
  - (3) <u>Signage/Fencing:</u> Tim Short will be working with Webb Russell to make the repairs and adjustments to signs
  - (4) Storage Container: Will be removed by mid-June

- Dedicated practice time at Glabicky Field (Gatchell's Green) and Coffin School for the Spring and Fall seasons during week nights and Saturdays.
- Games on Saturdays or Sundays at Hopkins Field during the Spring. The NSFFL would be looking for a total of four hours of time on Hopkins Field during the Spring.
- In return for use of field space, the NSFFL would make a donation to the Park Donation account of \$700 each Fall for the maintenance and repair of fields used for practice. The NSFFL would make a donation to the Park Donation account in the amount of \$20 per each child participant each Spring for use of Hopkins field and the maintenance and repair of fields used for practice.

We look forward to working with the Commission now and in the future to ensure the maintenance of Marblehead fields.
