Recreation and Parks Meeting Minutes 01/20/2015

- 1) Call to order: Linda called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.
- 2) Attendance:
 - a) Present (constituting a quorum): Jerry, Sam, and Linda.

- 3) Minutes of last meeting: Motion made and seconded to approve the minutes of the 1/06/2015 meeting; all in favor.
- 4) Appearance:
 - a) <u>Haley & Ward:</u> Conservation Committee has concern about drainage issues so volume of sub-ground drainage will need to be increased (handout attached). This will increase cost by roughly \$43,000. Haley & Ward will be submitting updated plans to Conservation Committee on 1/29/2015 and they will be reviewed on 2/6/15.
 - b) <u>Farm Direct: Motion made to allow the Farm Direct CO-OP to create new storage shed where current one currently resides near Stramski Way.</u> The structure will go from 8x10 to 10x12 so that storage containers can go inside. Approved

Reynolds Playground Field Renovations Meeting Outline January 20, 2015

Drainage

- > Drawing 3 (draft), detail sheets 3-6 (draft)
- ➤ Increase in volume from previous design. (from 0.26 acre-feet to .46 acre-feet)
 - Area had to be modeled to answer the questions from Conservation Commission meeting 09-11-2014.
 - Storage volume increased to accommodate modeled inflow from Hoods Lane area
 - Post development decrease in runoff from field (zero)
- > Cost increase for additional volume
 - ~\$22k additional in pipe materials (\$51k in pipe at 0.46 af storage, vs.~\$29k in pipe for 0.26 af storage)

Irrigation

- > Standard or manufacturer preference for irrigation heads?
- ➤ Currently considering Hunter I-20 & I-40 rotors

Lighting

- > Draft lighting plan complete
- > Option between TV or LED lights. LED has higher initial investment, but lower operating costs and greater spectator comfort. Waiting on specific pricing information from supplier.
