## Recreation and Parks Meeting Minutes 10-02-12

<u>NOTE</u>: The following is a **summary** of matters submitted at a meeting of the Recreation and Parks Commission in accordance with <u>M.G.L Chapter 39</u> and the <u>Massachusetts Open Meeting Laws</u>. Meetings are often recorded and tapes used as an aid.

- 1) Call to order: Chairman Chip Osborne called the 10/02/12 meeting to order at 7:30 PM.
- 2) Attendance:
  - a) Present (constituting a quorum): Chip, Derek, Linda, Jerry, and Bob.
  - b) Absent: None.
- 3) Minutes of last meeting(s): Motion made and seconded to approve the minutes of the 09/18/12 meeting; all in favor.
- 4) Appearances: Walter Jacobs appeared to present a scope of work plan (attached) for the Board's consideration. Discussion included: roofing, siding, materials, lighting, HVAC, insulation; department staff use, contractors and subcontractors use, security, safety features, utilities, and design. Walter walked through the property with 3 different contractors and got a ball park figure of @ \$100 K for "phase 1" of the project (basement, locker storage, roofing and siding). Board thanked Walter for all his work and will begin considering how to raise funds for "phase 1" to be done as soon as possible; Brendan will contact the Town Planner to discuss the procedures for bidding contractors and subcontractors.

#### 5) Reports (see attached). Addendum:

- a) Jim's: No addendum.
- b) Brendan's:
  - i) Float Storage: distributed Notice of Intent (see attached); public meeting scheduled 10/11/12.
  - ii) Memorial Park: estimate of \$8900.00 from Dave Peach for granite installation; Brendan will seek 3 bids.
  - iii) Gatchells': Brendan working with Sports Turf Specialties and Youth baseball regarding "Double A" and "Major League" field repair.
  - iv) Redd's Pond: Board OK with weed removal as proposed.

#### 6) New Business:

- a) Brendan's (see report). Addendum: Facility Stickers. Board feels an increase to \$75.00 is too much for people only wanting to go to the beach that don't use the transfer station. They instead would like the Board of Health to do 2 stickers: a \$55 transfer station sticker and a \$30 beach sticker which would allow the stickers to be put on the correct side of the vehicles for each location. The Board believes this will also increase revenue for the Town. Brendan will relay this feedback to the Board of Health.
- b) <u>Dept Reorganization</u>: Brendan feels it is time to update policies and procedures in the department. This would include updating job descriptions and specifically defining procedures for full time, part time, and seasonal park maintenance staff, office staff, and recreational staff to include standard safety and operating procedures, hierarchy, responsibilities, accountability, and expectations. Brendan will work with the staff, the Union, and the Town Administrator to ensure compliance with all laws, policies, and contractual agreements. Board in agreement and will help as needed; Brendan will begin working on updating job descriptions immediately.
- c) <u>Jerry:</u> Jerry received a request from a resident to have a Christmas tree in Memorial Park. Board agreed a Christmas tree in the park is inappropriate. The Chamber of Commerce is also looking for a place to have a Town Christmas tree and is in discussion with the Town.
- d) Correspondence (see attached): 3 Informational items; no actions required.

  - i) Park Staff to do the removal of the ceiling of the Stramski Garage to check the structure underneath before any roof proposals are put out to bid.
  - ii) CDM Smith Proposal: Chip queried the board regarding spending revolving fund money for the creation of a concept plan. Discussion included: seeking other bids for the rendering; scope of project; fill; irrigation; partnering with the Charter School; and funding. Chip estimated the costs of all documentation/renderings for the project could go as high as \$80K for all the plans required. After discussion: **Motion** made and seconded to allow Brendan to put together a concept plan rendering spending no more than \$20K from the revolving fund; all in favor.

# Recreation Commission Meeting October 2, 2012 Superintendent's Report

#### Parks / Fields

The staff has been over seeding and fertilizing the athletic fields and should be finished by the end of the week.

#### **Memorial Park**

The contract for memorial park has been drawn up and sent to Cassidy Brothers Forge, Inc. I expect it back to us at some point next week.

#### Gatchells

I have been meeting with representatives from baseball about the work needed on the Double A field at Gatchells. The fields have been marked out and we are looking at a combined project with our staff and the baseball to rehab the Double A field and repair the edges on the Major League field. I will have a cost estimate early next week.

#### **Reds Pond**

I received an email from a neighbor at Red's Pond regarding the phragmites in the pond. She would like to have them removed, at her expense, before they become a larger problem. She has a landscaper (Plants and Pleasantries) who is ready to go if approved.

#### Float Storage

I have been working with Town Counsel and the Conservation Commission on a Notice of Intent and Order of Conditions for Riverhead and Devereux Beach. The request will cover all of the work that is done on the property as it pertains to hauling, storage, repair, maintenance, and launching of floats. The NOI will be heard at the Conservation Commission meeting on Thursday, October 11, 2012.

#### **Old Business**

- Gatchell's basketball courts Truebounce has installed the new backboards and the court has received the final coat of asphalt. I have spoken with N E Sealcoating and they are looking at the end of this week to put down the latex surface.
- Beach The lifeguard chairs, boardwalks, signs, parking shed, mobi-matt and some of the picnic tables have been brought in for the season. We left out a few benches and picnic tables under the main pavilion.
- CDM Smith proposal What did you think?
- Stramski Roof I mistakenly copied the wrong sheet for the Stramski house roof repair. The cost to repair / replace the garage roof would be \$2,378.00 if our staff does the work with supervision from the Garland Company and \$7,373.00 (estimated) if we bid the project. The main house roof is estimated at \$9,990.00. This was the average of three companies that Garland uses to bid on jobs. I would like to put the two projects out to bid as one large project. I think we will be able to get a better together than split as two projects.

#### **New Business**

• Facility Stickers – The Board of Health is currently reviewing the cost of the Facility Sticker. In comparison with other towns and basic inflation the board feels that the price should be raised to \$75.00 with additional stickers costing \$10.00, which is the current price. In the past the Park and Recreation Commission has weighed in on the cost of the facility sticker. The Board of health would like some feedback so they can make their decision.





The Board of Appeals will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, October 23, 2012 at 8:30 PM in the Selectmen's meeting room of Abbot Hall, 188 Washington Street, Marblehead, on the application of Deidra Colcord to vary the application of the present Zoning By-law by allowing a Special Permit to construct an addition and deck at 59 Orne Street, Map 187 Parcel 13, in a Shoreline Central Residence District, Harborfront District and Historic District. The new construction is within the rear yard setback and exceeds the 10% expansion limits on a pre-existing non-conforming property that has less than required rear yard setback, side yard setback and exceeds the maximum height allowed.
