The following By-Law was adopted at the Adjourned Annual Town Meeting held May 1, 2023, and is hereby published in accordance with the provisions pursuant to G.L. c. 40, § 32.

## Town of Marblehead General Bylaw

Article 48 Summer Break from Gas Powered leaf Blower

## 75-3 **Enforcement**

- A. The Marblehead Police Department and the Marblehead Health Department and their respective designees ("Enforcing Authority") shall have the authority to administer and enforce any violation of this bylaw.
- B. The property owner upon whose property the violation shall have occurred shall be responsible for compliance with this bylaw. All warnings and fines shall be issued to the property owner.
- C. In the event the Enforcing Authority witnesses a violation hereof, the Enforcing Authority shall require the person in violation to immediately cease using the gas power leaf blower.
- D. The following penalties shall apply: For the first violation, a written warning shall be issued. For the second violation a fine of \$100 shall be issued. For the third and any violation thereafter a fine of \$200 shall be issued. Each violation shall constitute a separate violation.

Pursuant to G.L. c. 40, § 32, neither general nor zoning by-laws take effect unless the town has first Satisfied the posting/publishing requirements of that statute. Once this statutory duty is fulfilled.

- (1) general by-laws and amendments take effect on the date that these posting and publishing requirements are satisfied unless a later effective date is prescribed in the by-law, and
- (2) zoning by-laws and amendments are deemed to have taken effect from the date they were voted by Town Meeting, unless a later effective date is prescribed

Claims of Invalidity by reason of any defect in the procedure of adoption or amendment may only be made within 90 days of this posting. Per Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 40: Section 32
