



# WHAT IF MY CAR GETS TOWED DURING A SNOW EMERGENCY?

**WHO DO I CALL?** If your vehicle is towed during a snow emergency you should call the Marblehead Police Department's non-emergency phone line at (781) 631-1212 to confirm the location of your vehicle.

**WHERE IS MY CAR?** Towed vehicles will be stored at the Town's impound lot located at the transfer station, 5 Woodfin Terrace.

**HOW DO I GET MY CAR BACK?** Vehicles will be released only to registered owners. Owners will need to possess proof of ownership, proof of insurance, a valid driver's license, and proof that the fine has been paid in order to claim the vehicle. Bill's Auto Clinic, the Town's towing contractor, should be contacted at (978) 745-2087 to make arrangements to release the vehicle. If the vehicle is not claimed after a 72 hour period the vehicle will be towed to Bill's Auto Clinic at 2 Commercial Street in Salem.

**HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?** Town Meeting approved an increase in the snow emergency violation ticket to \$100. If your vehicle is towed, you will also be charged a towing charge of \$108 for the tow, a storage charge of \$35 per day, and a mileage charge if the vehicle requires a tow to Bill's Auto Clinic Tow Yard.
