

Town of Marblehead **Dog License Application**

In accordance with MGL c. 140 §136 and Marblehead By-Laws all dogs six (6) months old or older are required to be licensed. Dog licenses are renewed annually (January 1st of each year)

To renew a dog license or obtain a license for a new dog please follow the instructions below: Dog license fees:

INTACT DOG (or without spay/neuter certificate) -\$20.00(each dog) SPAYED/NEUTERED DOG (with spay/neuter certificate) - \$15.00 (each dog)

 - Current rabies certificate, and spay neuter certificate (if applicable) from your vet or you may contact us to make sure we have updated information on file.
 - No need to include a self- addressed stamped envelope
 - Dog tags will be mailed to you

New dogs must provide a current rabies certificate and spay/neuter certificate (If applicable) in order to obtain a license. **New dogs cannot be licensed online**.

Per MGL C140 §136 dog licenses cannot be issued without a valid rabies certificate.

Reminder a \$50.00 a month fine per dog will be assessed starting on February 1st each calendar year
