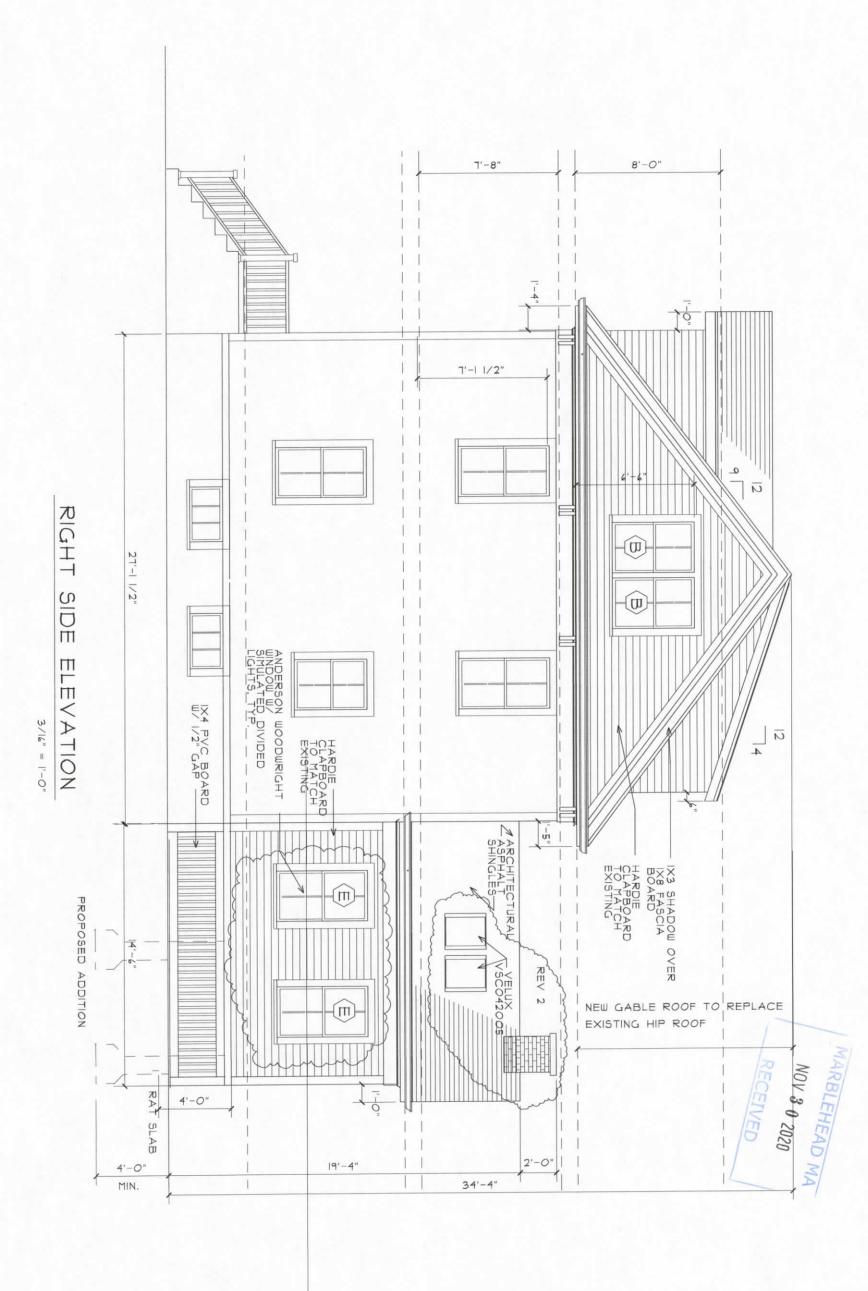
- does require the addition of a chimney stack for venting. The chimney meets the required code of distance and fireplace, ie.. gas or wood burning. We have decided to go with a wood burning option as a prefab firebox, but drawings set which approval was given. The clarification was it was not identified at the time the type of Fireplace - The fireplace as a part of the family room extension was also considered and on the original dimensions from house. See new drawings for added chimney.
- 2 Window Placement – the number of windows and size are the same on the extension. But we have decided to move a window from the right elevation to the left elevation to balance the light in the room.
- ω elevation to bring in more light to the vaulted ceilings in that room. Skylights (2) - We also decided with moving the window to left elevation, to add 2 skylights to the right
- 4 Sliding Door Clarification - On the plans was a French / sliding door. We kept the size of door the same and in same place as the original plans, but in light of the size of the room, chose to do a sliding door over French doors. The original plans may have shown French doors.
- 5 Foundation – In the original drawings we showed a crawl space which has a block base. We decided to do an are still exactly the same as original approved drawings, we just chose piers and a slab vs. blocks. open crawl space and leverage footings. This allows for easier access and storage. The space, dimensions, etc.

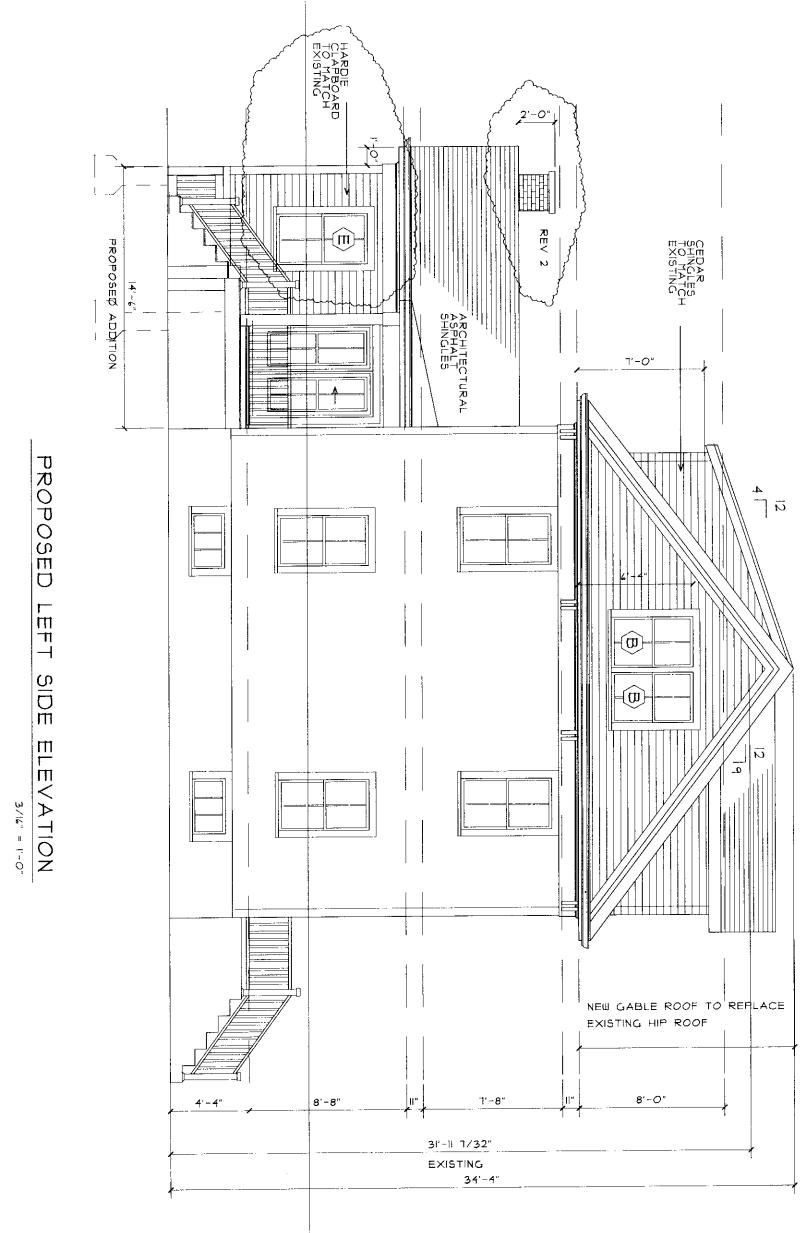
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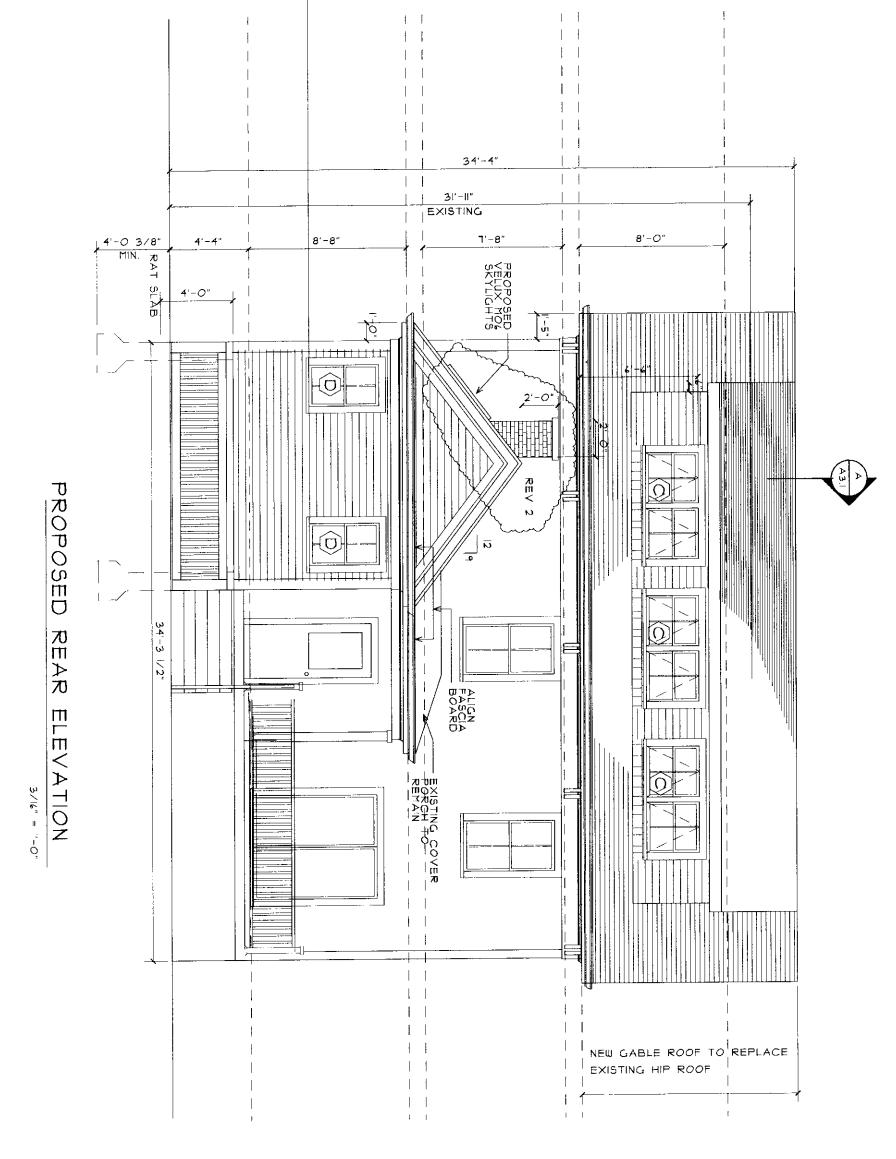
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
